

Covid-19 Policy

For the safety of our patrons and staff the following policies take effect immediately. Non-compliance will result in patrons being asked to leave the building.

- Face mask that completely covers the mouth and nose are required while in the Library. Hands, shirts, or other clothing are not acceptable face coverings. Staff will offer a mask to the patron if they do not have one. Doorside pickup and online access are available for patrons who are unwilling or unable to comply with the policy.
- Do not enter the building if you are sick or in quarantine.
- Maintain physical distancing from staff at all times.
- Gatherings are not permitted.
- Family groups should stay together. Children aged 8 and under must be attended by a responsible caregiver (age 18 or over) at all times while in the library.
- No one under the age of 8 will be allowed entry into the building without adult supervision. Please read our unattended child policy.
- Public computer sessions are limited to 1 hour. Computer use is available on a first come first serve basis.
- The meeting room is closed to the public at this time except for Library programming.
- Tutoring or remote schooling is not permitted.
- No food or drink.
- No one is permitted to sit on the floor or move furniture. Outside furniture may not be brought into the Library.
- All other patron rules and policies remain in effect.
